**FLIGHT INFORMATION DISPLAYS PLANNED  
FOR CLARK/LAKE CTA STATION**

Mayor Richard M. Daley today asked the Chicago City Council to approve an agreement between the Chicago Department of Aviation and the Chicago Transit Authority (CTA) to install two flight information display systems inside the CTA's Clark/Lake Station to assist passengers traveling to O'Hare and Midway International Airports.

"This agreement would allow for residents and visitors to access timely airport departure information while riding the Blue and Orange CTA Lines," said Mayor Daley. "This is one of the new and innovative ways we are enhancing public transportation and helping people plan their trips to O'Hare and Midway."

The Clark/Lake Station connects Blue Line travelers to O'Hare and Orange Line travelers to Midway and is the primary transfer point where the two transit lines merge. The Blue Line display would be located above the Blue Line platform. The Orange Line display would be installed on the west wall of the customer waiting area near the doors to the Orange Line platform.

Upon approval by the City Council and the CTA Board, construction will begin and the display systems should be completed this summer.

Similar planning is underway to install flight information display systems in other locations.
