## **BRIDGE RE-CONSTRUCTION NEAR O'HARE COMPLETED**

*All lanes on I-190 have been reopened*

(CHICAGO) Travelers heading toward O'Hare International Airport can expect all lanes on I-190 West to be open as the Department of Aviation Phase I bridge work has been completed on time.

The I-190 westbound on-ramp from Mannheim Road north was reopened over the weekend in conjunction with Phase I completion.

Phase II of the I-190 westbound bridge re-construction is scheduled to begin spring 2008.
