The City's efforts to reduce the wait times at Midway International Airport continues to have positive impacts to the traveling public. The City continues to work with the TSA to ensure the appropriate resources are available at Midway.

Focus	As of October 31, 2016
Average Wait Time 	Passengers are experiencing average wait times of <u>less than 5 minutes.</u>
Average Wait Times During Peak Travel Periods 	During peak travel times, passengers are waiting an average of <u>10 minutes.</u> The maximum wait time for the month of October was <u>21 minutes.</u>
Canine Teams 	TSA has added <u>2 additional temporary Canine Teams</u> for coverage during peak times.
Screening Officers 	Since early May, TSA has <u>61 additional Screening Officers</u> and converted <u>33 part time Screening Officers to full time.</u>
