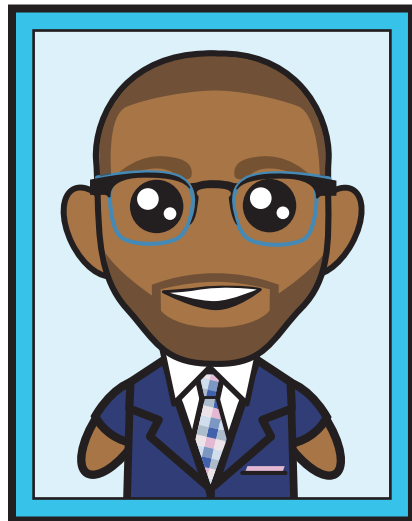
We hope you enjoy your time at our airports. And as we like to say to visitors to Chicago, we're glad you're here!

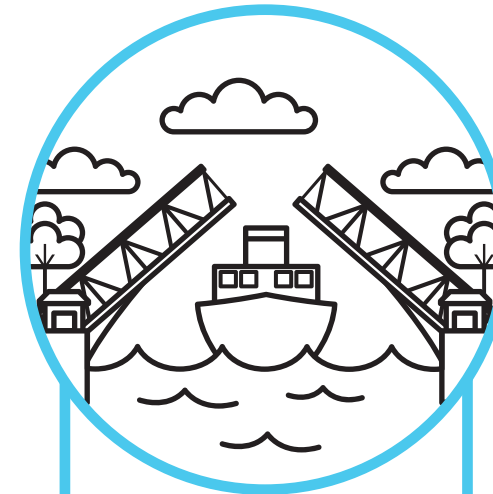
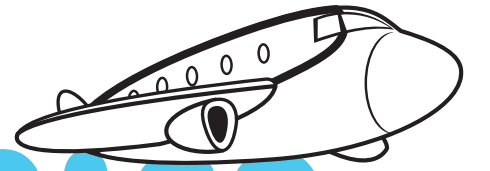
We have puzzles, mazes, and coloring activities for you to enjoy while you're in our airports.

Chicago River

The Chicago River runs right through the city and connects the Great Lakes with the Mississippi River Basin. It has a place of honor on the Flag of Chicago represented by two horizontal blue stripes. The direction of its flow was reversed in 1900 to protect the city's water supply.

Willis Tower

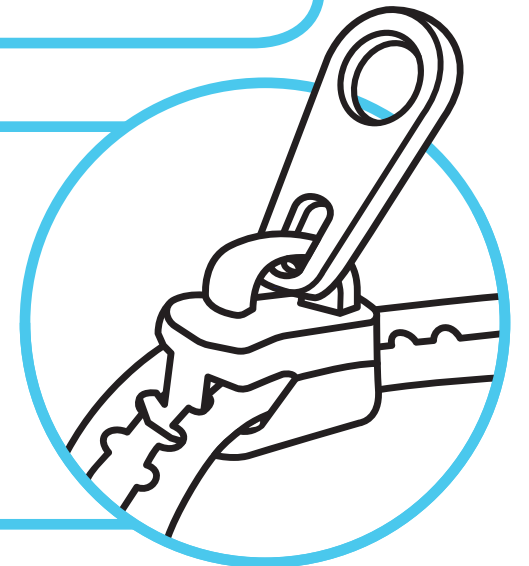
If you go to the very top of Willis Tower (formerly Sears Tower) you can see Lake Michigan and 4 states; Illinois, Michigan, Wisconsin, and Indiana.

The Ledge at Willis Tower's Skydeck is the highest observation deck in the United States, standing 1,353 feet in the air and extending 4.3 feet from the Skydeck.



Zippers!

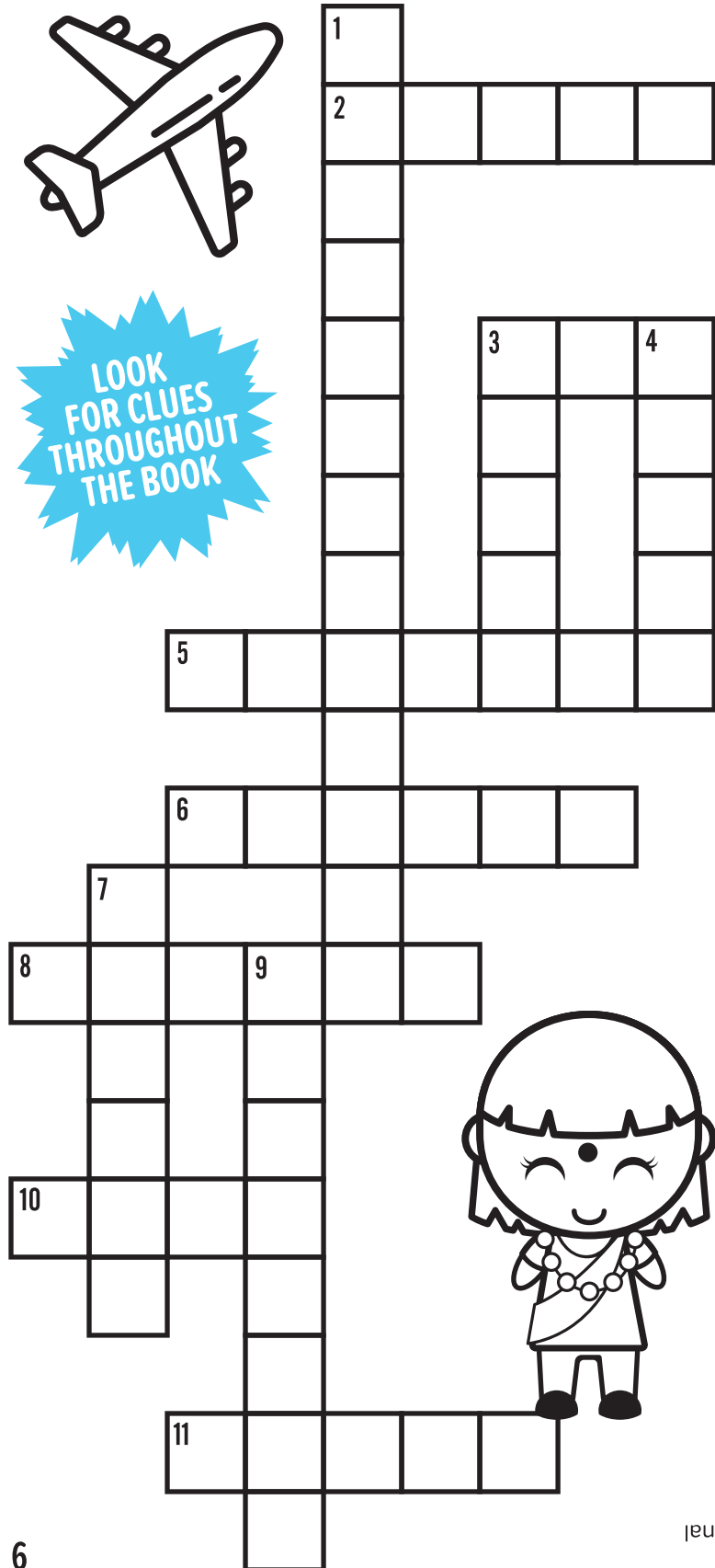

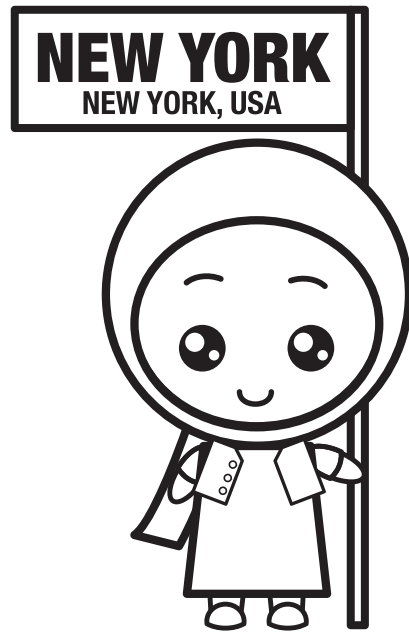

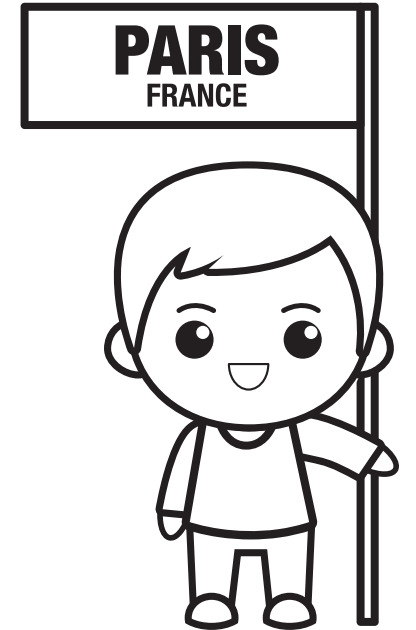
